

# Pilgrim Festival Chorus Minutes of Meeting

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 6:40 pm.

**Secretary's Report:**

The reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was waived by voice vote. The minutes, as presented on the website were **approved** as presented.

**Board Nominations:**

On behalf of the Board, C. Dorchester placed the following names into nomination for three year terms on the Board of Directors: **Nancy Morse, Paul Scheid, Larry Marracini, Cliff Fredericks**. There being no further names put forward, the nominations were closed. By unanimous vote, the Secretary cast a single ballot for the new Board members.

**New Business:**

1. D. Post mentioned that PFC commemorative t-shirts were still available. The price had been reduced to \$10.
2. C. Melahoures presented the concert dress for the June concert:
